



 Internal Assessment scores for each course will be considered to classify the student into one of the following category:
• + 65 % - Self Study • 56% -65% - Low risk (require monitoring) • 45%-55% - at risk category
 30%-44% - Medium risk (need intervention) Less than 30% - High risk (need intervention)
 Following intervention strategies to enhance performance of the weak students: 1. Group learning tests open book answers presentation on a pre-identified topics Direct mentoring
 additional classes in some topics* mock exams in one or more predetermined questions and mock viva
3. Remedial strategy for the varied risk categories: <u>A student-centered approach:</u>
It was agreed that strategies will be based on a student-centered approach . The student-centered approach is one in which the learning is self-directed and the goals are self-determined . Accordingly, the student or group of students belonging to the category will identify the strategy suitable for them . The assessment of performance will be by the students of the group , e.g., evaluating the answers, or providing feedback, etc. If there is a lone student in a group then, academically strong students can serve as the evaluator. The tutor will be a facilitator

to achieve the students' goal. The following table shows appropriate group of strategies for each of the categories.

Table: Risk category and their corresponding remedial strategies

30%-44% - (Medium risk)	Writing: Open book answers followed by Without seeing on same topic Mock exams and/or viva on selected whole topics Mock exam on two or three topics one to one mentoring
Less than 30% - (High risk)	May require additional classes in some topics + Writing: Open book answers to specific question+ mock exams in one or more questions + and mock viva on a small portion of the topic

Action plan to implement the intervention plans with the current students those performed poorly

- Two-hours /week for remedial learning for each batch
 Every Tuesday 09.00 -to 11.00 am will be allotted for the remedial classes.
- 2. Minimum of one hour/course will be given
- 3. One faculty/course will be assigned as a facilitator
- 4. If a student requires intervention to more than two courses than additional hours will be scheduled depending upon the availability of instructor and student.
- To implement the plan the risk categories of the students for each course was requested based on the internal assessment results. Mr. Vinith is assigned responsible for the task.

- 6. Faculties are requested to identify the course for which they will be the facilitator
- 7. The list will be shared to the students in a meeting.


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


