

Neonatal hearing screening using Oto Acoustic Emission Screener is done in all Government Maternity Hospitals in Kerala under State Initiative on Disabilities. The Goal of the programme is to facilitate early intervention of hearing loss. As the programme is about four years old, it is high time to check the efficiency of the project and to measure the outcome of the project.

As per ref 1st cited, National Institute of Speech and Hearing, Trivandrum has submitted a proposal to initiate a study on the efficiency of the project and to identify steps to take the programme to international standards. An amount of Rs. 4,95,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Ninetyfive thousand only) vide ref 2nd cited has been proposed by NISH to complete the project in Trivandrum District as a pilot for a duration of 12 months. As the Universal Hearing Screening Programme needs to be evaluated the proposal can be considered.





Attaching the required corrections and required modifications in UHSP Software

UHSP Software for hearing screening. Govt of Kerala

Corrections

Details collected to be given in an excel sheet along with the various analysis power.

- The current excel sheet needs to include details like date of birth, date of first screening, Date of second screening, details of referrals to other centres.
- Also the excel sheet should have the pass and refer column. That is, if a baby is having 3 or more than 3 for right and left, the next column should have a pass entered in it automatically. Also if the baby is having less than 3, in either right or in left, the column should have a refer entered. Which will make the tracking easy. The same should happen even for a baby who is coming for the retest.
- Single row for a single baby which will make tracking easy for the baby. Arranging the excel sheet as one row for one baby, with their first screening, second screening, pass/refer in each test, referral centers, and the various centers they received the services

Modifications

- To include a column for total deliveries happening in each hospital
- List of referral centers (government and private) needs to be updated
 - Referral screening centers with OAE
 - Referral diagnostic centers with ABR/BERA, OAE and hearing aid fitting
- System should be capable of storing the details of all investigation details (to type data, to attach scanned reports, and voice recordings) related to schedules, follow-ups/ revisit details and status of various reviews.
- Arranging the excel sheet as one row for one baby, with their first screening, second screening, date of the diagnostic evaluation, date of first amplification and date of starting intervention and the various centers they received the services
- Utilities to review reports of
 - demographic details,
 - details of screening,
 - details of diagnostic evaluations,
 - details of selection and fitting of amplification devices,
 - intervention details and its outcome,
 - integrated school details
 - Details of routine health care programs for infants
 - Details of changes in hearing status

- The software should have the facility to send SMS messages and automated emails and messages to parents, administrators, centers providing services, village offices, RBSK etc.
- Fully functional dashboard with all needed details
- Login facilities to all referral centers (Government and private) and facility to enter the various assessment details and reports
- The system should be capable of doing automatic analysis of follow up, and a red star if the baby has not reported for rescreening, for diagnostic evaluation and intervention. This can be provided in the excel sheet, also can be provided to the administrators and to the login centers where they are referred. This can be done by calculating the days after birth, initial screening, second screening, diagnostic evaluation, and amplification.
- Automated reports should be generated every month regarding the
 - percentage of initial screening.
 - Missed initial screening,
 - percentage of second screening,
 - list and percentage of missed second screening,
 - List and Percentage of babies undergoing diagnostic evaluations,
 - List and Percentage of babies fitting with amplification devices
 - List and Percentage of babies undergoing early intervention within six months of birth
 - List and Percentage of babies missing schedules for a second screening, diagnostic evaluations, amplification and early intervention
 - The automated list should be of each centers having hearing screening facility and combined state percentage
 - etc

AND WHEREAS, K-DISC has selected NISH to supervise and implement the Program, Innovation by Youth with Disability (henceforth referred as "the Program") to identify and train Youth with Disability (YwD) to innovate.



AND WHEREAS through proceedings No. 119/2019/KDISC dated 07/01/2019, K-DISC accorded administrative sanction to operate the Program through NISH and sanctioned the transfer of Rs.1.36 crores (Rupees 136 lakhs) towards implementation expenses for the Program spanning across financial year 2018-19 and financial year 2019-20 (The above said order forms part of this agreement).

NOW THEREFORE K-DISC and NISH have come together to record their intention through this MOA, as set out herein below:


1. It is agreed by the parties that aforesaid Program shall be implemented by NISH, consistent with the Annexure I, which constitutes the Implementation Guidelines for the overall program. Annexure II specifies the activities, which shall be the responsibility of NISH, and the associated budgets. Both Annexures I and II are part of the agreement.
2. This MOA is for Phase 1 of the Program, which is to be completed between January 2019 and March 31st, 2019.
3. NISH shall utilize the fund only as agreed with K-DISC. These include expenses for selecting youth for participating in the PI-YwD, development of curriculum, training and capacity development, consultants, advisors, and staff honorariums or top-ups, administration, office equipment, and investment costs, organization of camps/seminars for upto 100 youth, operating charges, travel, accommodation and food expenses and other miscellaneous expenses as agreed.
4. NISH shall initiate all necessary steps to implement the Program and shall commence operation of the Program as early as possible once the MOA is signed.
5. K-DISC shall release the amount of Rs. **47,50,000/-** (Rupees Forty Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) by transfer credit to NISH in its PTSB Account No. 799012700000186 of District Treasury, Thiruvananthapuram in multiple installments.
6. An advance of Rs. Twenty lakhs (20 lakhs) shall be transferred to NISH upon signature as a first instalment.
7. The second instalment shall be released upon request by NISH along with utilization certification for 80% of the first instalment.
8. NISH shall procure any goods and services necessary for implementation consistent with NISH's procurement guidelines. On the completion of the Program, NISH shall submit utilization certificate and statement of expenditure to K-DISC.
9. NISH shall submit to K-DISC before June 30, 2019, audited statements of expenditure.
10. At the end of the financial year 2018-19, NISH shall refund to K-DISC, the unutilized funds unless otherwise agreed.
11. If there is any material deviation from the proposal, the Chair of K-DISC has the right to terminate the agreement.



12. In the event of discontinuation of the Program or upon termination, all unutilized funds will be returned to K-DISC, unless otherwise agreed. In addition, upon such discontinuation or termination, NISH will return all remaining assets obtained under this Program to K-DISC or will refund the equivalent depreciated value.
13. If any dispute arises on the operation of the Program it shall be settled between Chair, K-DISC and Executive Director, NISH and if such settlement is not possible the matter shall be referred to Government and the decision of Government shall be final.



Annexure I: Implementation Guidelines for Disability Program: KSSM-KDISC Talent/Innovation Search for Youth with Disability- Guidelines

Introduction and Background

1. Kerala-Development and Innovation Strategic Council's (K-DISC) Young Innovators Program (YIP) targets children and youth to empower future innovators to innovate new products, services or models to meet emerging requirements, unarticulated needs, or existing market needs of the society more effectively through a specially designed challenge. K-DISC recognizes that inclusion of all children and youth is essential for innovation. Equally, it recognizes that without special attention and much greater and caring effort, youth with disabilities cannot be brought into the mainstream. Challenging as it is, KDISC, therefore, proposes to include a special component in its YIP program
2. More importantly, India's *The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act – 2016* aims for the full and effective participation and inclusion of persons with disabilities in society, and seeks respect for the evolving capacities of children with disabilities and respect for the right of children with disabilities to preserve their identities. Section 29 of the 2016 Act requires the appropriate Government and the local authorities to take measures to promote and protect the rights of all persons with disabilities to have a cultural life and to participate in recreational activities equally with others, which includes facilities, support and sponsorships to artists and writers with disability to pursue their interests and talents. The proposed Program is, therefore, fully in line with the spirit and provisions of the legislation.
3. *K-DISC fully recognizes that such an effort will hold high risks, the complexity and the pioneering nature of this Program.* However, there can be no innovation without risks, and it is anticipated that some of these risks can be mitigated by taking a (i) a phased approach, (ii) combining the search for innovators along with a preliminary search for talent¹, and (iii) engagement of experts from an early stage in discussing and addressing the issues that need to be resolved. K-DISC also proposes to enhance the ecosystem for disability through support to KSSM for a participatory process to formulate a draft policy for Assistive Technology (AT).
4. K-DISC, therefore, support three sets of activities that will together create a conducive ecosystem in the State to support youth with disability, as well as their caregivers and communities. These activities include:
 - a. An Innovative Program for 20 Youth with Disability to become innovators and change leaders to be implemented by NISH;

- b. A Talent/Innovation Search for 80 Youth with Disability, proposed by Kerala Social Security Mission (KSSM), and to be implemented by them;
- c. Formulation of a policy for Assistive Technology by Department of Social Justice, appropriate for Kerala, through a highly innovative process of consultation.

Overall Program

1. K-DISC now proposes to partner with the Social Justice Department (SJD), namely NISH and KSSM to organize a Talent/Innovation Search for youth with disability. The Talent/Innovation Search aims to identify 100 youth with disability between the ages of 15 and 40 who stand out as being motivated, creative, talented and passionate, and with potential to think differently and innovate when placed in a supportive and facilitating environment.
2. These Guidelines provides the framework and guidance for organizing the Search. These Guidelines will be reviewed and revised as necessary at the end of the financial year, that is March 31st, 2019.

Supervisory and Supportive Mechanisms

3. For the purposes of this first phase, since the project contours have been well firmed up between K-DISC, KSSM, and NISH there shall be a **Program Advisory Committee (PAC)** consisting of the Director, Social Justice, the Executive Director of KSSM, a representative of K-DISC, a representative of ICCONS, two representatives with disabilities from civil society nominated by K-DISC, as well as an external advisor. PAC will be chaired by K-DISC, and NISH shall be the convener of the Committee.
4. PAC shall meet every month to appraise the progress, confirm that implementation is consistent with the agreement, and provide any guidance as needed.

Responsibilities of Different Stakeholders

5. Program I-YwD is being implemented in two phases, both being managed by NISH under an agreement between K-DISC and NISH. An agreement will be signed between NISH and K-DISC and these guidelines will constitute part of this agreement.
6. NISH will constitute a temporary **mini-secretariat** to support the implementation of this Program. The responsibilities of the mini-secretariat shall be as follows:
 - a. Maintaining a data base of all the applicants with their details in a format to be agreed with KSSM and K-DISC;
 - b. Scrutinizing applications to confirm that they meet eligibility criteria, and excluding those that do not, with a clear notation as to why they do not.
7. NISH will be responsible for selection of 100-120 YwDs between the ages of 15 and 40 based on the applications received and as per these Guidelines. Through the

screening process stated herein, NISH, in consultation with PAC, will select up to 100 candidates(keeping 20 in reserve).²

8. NISH will then bring the 100 to a six-day Leadership camp for selection of 20 YwD, who will be absorbed into the Innovation by YwD Program.
 - a. A special curriculum for the Leadership Camp will be finalized by NISH based on recommendations and input from a workshop of experts held on December 5-6, 2018, and through a 2-day workshop of experts.
 - b. At the Leadership camp, organized consistently with the above, NISH will organize a panel of judges, who will select upto 20 candidates who stand out as being most motivated, creative, talented and passionate based upon agreed criteria to be developed by NISH and the PAC, consistent with the workshop recommendations mentioned in the previous sub-section.
 - c. Based on the agreed curriculum, NISH will be responsible for training up to 15³ catalysts, ensuring a balance representative of different disabilities, who will help to organize and run the 6-day Leadership Camp.
 - d. During the camp, NISH will organize a mentoring session for the parents and caretakers of children with different disabilities
9. This will then lead to Phase II, where NISH will design a replicable and scaleable process for supporting YwDs to dream up innovative or different products, processes or services that they could support themselves, individual and community goals. NISH will need to:
 - a. Finalizing the approach. curriculum and methodology for the 60-day camp through a 2-day Planning Workshop of experts;
 - b. Planning and organizing the proposed 2-month mentoring camp for the 20 YwD selected for the I-YwD innovation Program;
 - c. Organizing three 3-day Seminars to discuss experience and to give participants specific inputs as well as to document the overall process; and
 - d. Organizing an exhibition of the ideas developed by the participating YwDs, as well as ensuring a final and independent evaluation of the whole program and recommendations for the way forward.
10. KSSM's role in this effort will be as follows:
 - a. Negotiating with Akshaya Centers for facilitating the submission of electronic applications,
 - b. Managing the advertisement for the Talent/Innovation search, ensuring that the message about the search reaches the grassroots level;
 - c. Addressing the needs of the 80 YwDs left in the Talent pool, after selection of youth for the Innovation by YwD (I-YwD) program by NISH. (KSSM's

program may be termed T-YwD). KSSM will be responsible for preparation of Individual Care Plans for these 80 YwDs, through providing opportunities for the enhancement of their talents, scholarships for selected youth; advanced training and skills development; support in assistive solutions and supportive devices; and mentor attachment as required.

- d. In addition, as part of T-YwD, KSSM will organization a state YwD Talent festival during April-May 2019, not only to give YwDs a chance to participate in such an event and display their talents, but also to enhance the ecosystem in the state by increasing the awareness the public, PwDs, their caregivers, and to improve the well-being of the participants.
- e. Items in 8 (c,d,e) may also go in here.

11. PAC shall ensure that the funds are being used by both organizations in the manner agreed with K-DISC.

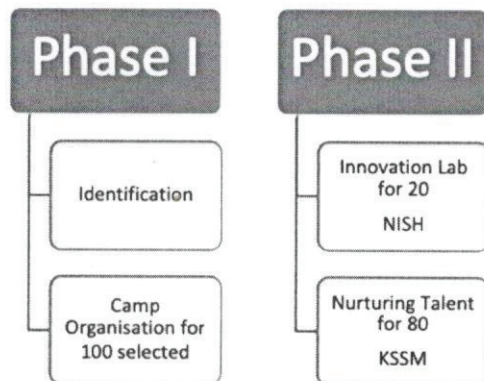


Figure 1: Phases in the Program

Implementing Guidelines for the Program

1. This section states the principles of the search agreed between K-DISC, KSSM, and NISH.

Eligibility for Participation

2. All residents of Kerala between the ages of 15 and 40 with benchmark disabilities and with proven records of talents and other capabilities are eligible to participate. For the purposes of this search, Youth with Disability includes those who have long-term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others.
3. Disability shall include anyone with the disability of more than 40%.⁴
4. Specifically, nominations are invited from those with:
 - a. Group I - Visual Disability:
 - a. Blindness,
 - b. Low Vision

⁴Parkinsonism is excluded, since it is very rare in the age group which has been selected for the program.

- b. Group II – Auditory Disability:
 - a. Deaf,
 - b. Hard of hearing,
 - c. Speech and Language Disability
- c. Group III Locomotor Disability:
 - a. Leprosy cured,
 - b. Dwarfism,
 - c. Acid Attack Victim,
 - d. Sickle cell anemia,
 - e. Hemophilia,
 - f. Thalassemia
- d. Group IV - Intellectual Disability:
 - a. Autism Spectrum Disorder,
 - b. Learning Disability,
 - c. Mental Illness
- e. Group V – Other Disability:
 - a. Cerebral Palsy,
 - b. Muscular Dystrophy,
 - c. Multiple Sclerosis
- f. Group VI – Multiple Disabilities

Types of Talent

5. Talents or innovations (doing anything differently from usual or producing an application that is new or different) are invited in the following 8 categories:
 - a. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)
 - b. Information technology (Development of Mobile Apps etc)
 - c. Crafts, particularly using indigenous materials and methods
 - d. Arts and Painting
 - e. Food, Diet, and Health
 - f. Music (vocal, instrumental, and composition)
 - g. Dance
 - h. Creative/Literary Writing
 - i. Video (even with mobile phones) or Photography.
 - j. Idea for a new or different product, service, business model, or process (agriculture, natural resource management, water conservation, environmental protection, disaster management or other area)
6. Each Applicant can apply for two of the above areas.

Announcement of Search

7. KSSM will develop a strategic advertisement and IEC plan for informing the public including at the grassroots about this opportunity for YwDs. Special efforts will also be made by KSSM to ensure that the advertisements are designed in such a manner as to ensure that they all enhance awareness of the need to include YwDs in the overall development of the state.
8. The Talent and Innovation Search will be announced through Malayalam and English dailies, Social Media, ICDS and Website of institutions of Social justice. Advertisement in film theatres and through the radio will also be undertaken.
9. The announcements will, detail eligibility norms, methodology of submission of applications. Other information will be available on the webpage. Radio and visual media will be used as will notice be provided to associations for various disabilities.

Application Process

10. In order to be balanced and ensure fairness to all, applicants will be divided into two groups: (i) Group A comprises of children below 18 years old and (ii) Group B of persons between the ages of 18 and 40, as on 01.01.2019. Based on the type and intensity the skill, applicants will be categorized into 6 Groups stated in para 5.
11. A quota will be established for each Group with the proportion of disability based on the Disability census organized by the Government once the applications have been received. This will be done by NISH in consultation with KSSM, and cleared by the Project Advisory Committee.
12. Applications can be submitted by the applicants, their parents, legal guardian, teachers, counsellors on behalf of the applicant.
 - a. The applicant can only apply online at <https://idearocket.typeform.com/to/dhMsmE> or a similar webpage which will be made available on the webpages of K-DISC, NISH, and KSSM.
 - a. The applicant should duly fill out details like name, email id, mobile number, etc., required in the form as per instructions given thereof.
 - b. Where the applicant finds it difficult to apply online, the applicant may seek support at the nearest Akshaya Centre, where help will be provided to file the application form⁵ for the Applicant(s), free of charge. However, a standard fee of Rs. 50 will be paid to the Akshaya Centre by KSSM for each application completely and properly submitted.
 - c. Any false information or misrepresentation in application will lead to disqualification at any stages of the events.

Details of Application form

13. The application form has been finalized by K-DISC consistent with the guidelines.

⁵Format of the application form will be made available in the website.

- a. A disability medical certificate from a authorized entity should be submitted by the applicant. Certificate to prove residency and age also required.
- b. Support documents to substantiate the talent and details of referees should be attached in the application form as stated therein. The referees may be a school teacher or principal (other than the person submitting the application), an elected representative, a Local Self-Government functionary, or a health staff. At least two referees and their contact details need to be provided.
- c. Documents showing the achievement (Photographs/Video/Audio/Computer files which shows talent of person) should support the application if required.

Preliminary Review (State level)

1. Applications received in each district will be reviewed first by the NISH Secretariat based on the documents submitted. Applications should then be classified into the two Groups – junior group consisting of 18 and below; and senior group consisting of above 18 and below 40. In each category of disabilities. (Below 18 and 18-40 suggested)
2. The secretariat should first conduct a preliminary review (Desk review) to see all the eligibility criteria are met. During this stage, the Applicant(s) that do not meet the eligibility criteria should be weeded out. At a second level, this scrutiny should involve a careful triangulation of the different types of information provided such as video clips, testimonials, and other documents.
3. Where applications are promising but lack clarity, the Secretariat may decide to seek a more in-depth scrutiny. If any verifications are needed, they may be sought telephonically and recorded in the files. At this stage, the Secretariat can conduct some verification by actually visiting the schools or homes of applicants to confirm the details in the application.
4. NISH will then constitute a panel of judges consisting of experts from various field. The panel will be set up after an understanding of the nature of skills reflected in the applications. The judges will include experts capable of making judgements, and a team of medical experts to determine the medical factor. An honorarium of up to Rs 5000 per day will be paid to each judge, depending on the qualifications and experience.
5. The panel of expert judges will be responsible for reviewing all eligible applications after the preliminary screening.
6. Out of the total number of applications, the Panel of judges will need to identify up to 120 youth with talent, consistent with the quota set by these guidelines. Reasons for selection or non-selection must be entered into the database. The following table provides some guidance as to the selection of the 120 participants from the desk review of applications. Any adjustments to the criteria will be made only in consultation with KSSM and the PAC.

Dimension	Score	Weightage
Skill	1-5	40%
Innovativeness/Creativity or Originality	1-5	25%
Capability in relation to disability**	1-5	25%
Scope for Further Development	1-5	10%

** The scoring looks at how the talent expressed is achieved covering the disability involved, Eg: a person with ability to sing while wheel chair bound will be 2 where as a wheelchair bound dancer will be 5.

7. Reasons for rejecting applicants must be recorded transparently in individual files. These must be available and maintained by the Secretariat in the event queries are raised by the applicants.
8. The accepted and rejected applications must then be provided to the PAC for final review. The PAC may decide to send some applications from either the rejected or accepted ones back to the Secretariat for review. PAC will have the final powers to accept or reject but must clearly state the reasons for such revision in the records. PAC's decision will be final.

State-level Review Mechanism:

A review mechanism* will be established at the state level for any complaints received on the selection process. KDISC will set up a panel for independent reviews of any complaints.

- a. Complaints can be made by the person submitting the application or the applicant in writing within five working days of receiving the decision.
- b. Any application for a review should be sent to the NISH Secretariat, who should forward it to the independent panel immediately, and provide all supporting documents for the decision within a period of 2 working days.
- c. The Independent Panel should make the decision within 5 working days and send the decision in writing to the Complainant, with a copy to the NISH.
- d. A response should be sent to the Complainant within 10 working days of receipt of the complaint by NISH.
- e. The decision of the independent panel will be final.

Help Line

9. For any assistance or information, a helpline will be established by KSSM. Applicant may also obtain information through district offices of the social justice Department of the Government of Kerala.

ORDER

As per the GO read as first above, Administrative Sanction was inter alia accorded by Government for the implementation of the Young Innovators Programme (YIP) at a total cost of ₹255.83 lakhs during the year 2018-2019.

The YIP targets children and youth to empower future innovators to innovate new products, services or models to meet emerging requirements, unarticulated needs or existing market needs of the society more effectively through a specially designed challenge. K-DISC recognizes that inclusion of all children and youth is essential for innovation. Equally recognises that without special attention and much greater and caring effort, youth with disabilities cannot be brought into the mainstream. Moreover, the Rights of Persons with Disability Act 2016 aim for the full and effective participation and contribution of persons with disabilities in society and seeks support for evolving capacities of children with disabilities and respect for the right of children with disabilities to preserve their identities. Section 29 of the Act 2016 requires the appropriate Government and the local authorities to take measures to promote and protect the right of all persons with disabilities to have a cultural life and to participate in recreational activities equally with others which include facilities, support and sponsorships to artists, writers with disability and pursue interests and talents.

In tune with the line and spirit of these provisions of legislation, a National workshop was conducted during early December 2018 on “Innovation by Youth with Disability” to identify and train Youth with Disability (YwD) to innovate. The project is conceived and executed with the support of the Kerala Social Security Mission (KSSM), National Institute of Speech and Hearing (NISH) and the Institute for Communicative and Cognitive Neurosciences (ICCONS). In order to enhance the ecosystem for disability, K-DISC supports three sets of activities that will work together to create a conducive ecosystem in the state to support Youth with Disability as well as their caregivers and communities. These activities include:

- a) A Talent/Innovation search for 100 Youth with Disability by KSSM and to be implemented by them.
- b) A programme for 20 Youth with Disability to become innovators and change leaders, to be implemented by NISH.
- c) Formulating a policy for Assistive Technology, appropriate for Kerala through a highly innovative process of consultation being led by Department of Social Justice.

In Consultation with the Social Justice Department, K-DISC has selected NISH & KSSM to supervise and implement part of the project. NISH & KSSM will be guided by a Programme Advisory Committee consisting of the following Members.

The Committee will be chaired by K-DISC.

A total amount of ₹ 1.945 crores is envisaged for two financial years ie. 2018-19 and 2019-2020.

In the circumstances Administrative Sanction is accorded to implement the Innovation of Youth with Disability (YwD) through NISH to identify and train Youth with Disability to innovate for a total cost of ₹1.36 crore for two financial years 2018-19 and 2019-20. A total amount of ₹47.5 lakhs will be released to NISH during the current year.

Sanction is also accorded to implement selected components of the talent search for Youth with Disability (YwD) through KSSM as part of strengthening the ecosystem for disability in the state at a total cost of ₹58.5 lakhs for the financial years 2018-19 and 2019-

2020. A total amount of ₹33.5 lakhs will be released to KSSM during the current financial year.

Expenditure in this regard will be met from the Head of Account "3451-00-092-92-34-03-Other items plan (V) from the current year budget.

This order is issued by virtue of the powers delegated to the Secretary as per the GO read as 2nd and 3rd paper above.



(v) The Accounts of the NISH shall be open for inspection by the Sanctioning Authority and Audit, both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provisions of C&AG (DPC Act 1971) and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever it is called upon to do.

(vi) No portion of the grant will be utilized for any purpose than for which grant is sanctioned.

(vii) The Executive Director, National Institute of Speech and Hearing, Thiruvanthapuram (Kerala) will submit a statement of expenditure along with a provisional utilization certificate within one year from the date of issue of the sanction order as prescribed in GFR 12 -C (GFR 2017).

(xvi) The Central Government may also prescribe such other conditions, as deemed necessary, before sanction/release of assistance.

(xvii) Fund will be utilized by National Institute of Speech and Hearing as per MOU signed.

(xviii) The assisted College shall not dispose of or lease out or create any charge over the assets created by utilizing the assistance provided under this Scheme, without written permission from Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

(xix) The assisted College shall not change the form or the basic character of the college without prior approval of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

(xx) The assisted college shall be required to run classes for graduation level for the hearing impaired students every year with all required aids/appliances and sign language interpreters. They also shall run the college as per UGC approved States/Central/UT administration by the State/UT Government norms.

(xxi) The financial assistance provided under the Scheme for expansion by upgrading computer programming & graphic laboratories would be of non-recurring and capital nature.

(xxii) The accounts of the assisted college shall be audited every year and the assisted college shall be required to submit annual report along with the financial statement to the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. The Annual Report would include the details of the construction activities, procurement of equipment/furniture, fixture, computers etc. during the year from the financial assistance provided by the Central Government and also the details of students taught in different subjects, classes as well as details of the successful hearing impaired students during the year.

(xxiii) The assisted college shall be required to maintain a fixed assets register of equipment/assets procured from the Central assistance and separate records containing details of the faculty members, staff sign language interpreters and administrators paid salaries/allowances by the utilizing grant funds, for verification by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities at any time.

(xxiv) The requirement of faculty, staff etc. for running the Deaf College for which financial assistance is provided shall be as per UGC approved States/Central/UT administration by the State/UT Government norms/registration under RCI. Details of Courses and faculty including student-

faculty ratio in the institutions being funded would be as per MOU signed between the Department and institutions, before sanction of project.

(xxv) In case of failure to utilize the sanctioned funds within time or its misuse, misappropriation or diversion of volition of any one or more of the conditions mentioned above, the Government will be entitled to recover the entire assistance amount with interest, in addition to taking such other legal and/or penal action, as deemed necessary.

(xxvi) The accounts of the project shall be properly and separately maintained. They shall always be opened to check by an Officer deputed by the Government of India or the State Government. They shall also be opened to a test check by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India at his discretion. The account will be liable to be audited as per GFR provisions.

(xxvii) If the Central Government or State Government has reason to believe that the grant is not being utilized for approved purpose, the Government of India may stop payment of further grants and recover earlier grant in such manner as they may decide.

(xxviii) The institute shall exercise reasonable economy in its working and particularly in respect of expenditure on procuring computer and other equipments.

(xxix) No change in the procurement plan will be made without the prior approval of the Government of India.

(xxx) Organization shall open a separate Bank account for this Scheme and furnish necessary documents at the time for applying for recurring grants like Statement of Accounts, Audited reports etc in full and in the prescribed format (consolidated and for the project). The audit report complete in every respect and to include, (a) Auditor's Report (b) Balance Sheet (c) Income & Expenditure Statement (d) Item-wise expenditure statement (e) Receipts & Payment Statement will all supporting schedule on fixed assets, investment, current assets, current liabilities, significant accounting policies and Note on account and the action taken/proposed to be taken by Org on the audit observations.

(xxxi) The organization/institution receiving grants under this Scheme shall submit Utilization Certificates (UCs) within one year from the date of issue of the sanction order as prescribed in GFR 12 -C (GFR 2017).

(xxxii) Applicant college may strictly to make all payments only through cheque/electronic transfer and not in cash. These transactions may be duly incorporated in the audited accounts of the project.

(xxxiii) Interest component on GIA released in advance may also be utilized for the project and shall be adjusted in the next release of grants-in-aid.
