- If scholar gets less than 40% in any paper (RA or Fail) in their first attempt, student has to repeat only that paper even if the aggregate is ≥ 225 (55%) and shall do so until he / she obtains the passing minimum of 40% and $\geq 55\%$ in aggregate.
- If student gets less than 225 in aggregate, he has to **repeat all** the papers.
- In cases of RA in one or more papers, passing session needs to be mentioned in the new marks statement.
- The Pass/ Fail (RA) declared for a course in the first attempt shall be taken and in case of RA for a course that course shall be repeated until he obtains $\geq 40\%$ for the said course and $\geq 55\%$ in aggregate.
